

TPMS DTC Error Clearing Function User Guide

Aim

- To delete the TPMS DTC error codes from the vehicle's ECU if it has some which have previously been stored in its memory.
- Once the error codes are cleared, the ECU will accept the Cub Sensors.


Notes

- Try this function if it is supported for a specific MMY and if the vehicle cannot relearn the Cub Sensors.
- Not all models in the current coverage require the ECU DTC TPMS error codes to be cleared for Cub Sensors to work in them.
- This function will only delete TPMS related DTC error codes and not any other types.
- As of European Firmware Update V1.37, the only model supported with this function is Toyota Auris 01/2014 – 06/2017.

1. Select the MMY's OBD II Function




2. Select OBD




3. Select Clear TPMS DTC and press Enter



4. Wait while the tool attempts to clear error codes.



5. If clearing is successful, this confirmation will appear:



6. Attempt to Relearn Cub Sensors

- Use the applicable method to relearn the Cub Sensors as usual.

7. If the TPMS DTC Error Clearing function is unsuccessful, this message will appear:



8. If Error E10 appears

- Please make sure the ACC is turned on in the car (the engine should remain off) and try again.
- If the Error E10 keeps showing up, please inform Cub Technical Support.


